Maybach Foundation protégé Vicky Roy was the official photographer for the International Award for Young People reception last night. Attended by HRH The Earl of Wessex, the event was held at the Kiton Building, where distinguished guests were treated to an evening celebrating 'Today's youth, tomorrow's leaders'. Hosted by Jon Parks, chairman of the World Healthcare Foundation, the event focused on opportunities young people need in order to become the next generation of leaders. As a 2004 recipient of the Gold Award, Mr. Roy was honored with The Duke of Edinburgh's Award during the event.

Mr. Roy's talent and promise have been recognized elsewhere as well. In 2008 he was nominated by the Ramchander Nath Foundation to participate in the World Trade Center Documentary Arts project in New York City. Sponsored by the Wilhelm & Karl Maybach Foundation and its partner Silverstein Properties, the project aims to capture the compelling story of the building of the new World Trade Center.

The Wilhelm & Karl Maybach Foundation provides promising young people who face adversity the opportunity to mentor with global leaders to make a profound and positive difference in their lives and in the lives of others. Mr. Roy arrived in New York in March 2009 to begin his mentorship and will remain through the end of July. As part of the project, Mr. Roy is working with WTC Photographer Joe Woolhead to document the rebuilding of this important American landmark.
